Members' profile: St Laurence Pre-school and Club 11 Ltd

The Long Eaton Chamber of Trade was delighted when Vicky Garavan and Cheryl Hughes became a member last year.



Originally set up 1984 as a playgroup at the St Laurence School and by the mid 90's they moved to larger premises at the Elder Citizens Centre on Tamworth Road.

Since June 2000 under the guidance of Cheryl and Vicky they have extended their provision to Pre-school, Nursery and Full Day Care with funding secured from Derbyshire Local Education Authority.

They are always full to capacity with 30 aged 3 to 4 years and 16 aged 2. Also on offer is a pre-school and club 11 which are registered and also inspected by Ofsted.

Their current premises are on Broad Street, within the library grounds and they have the benefit of a secure outdoor play area with various outdoor play equipment.

The rooms were refurbished last year by Erewash Borough Council and they also were given support and guidance throughout by the Council.
