# Members' update: Renaissance Studio -

Hand Made Passementerie 'The Jewellery of the home"

Renaissance Studio is one of only a handful of hand made trimming companies left in the UK.

Their in-house rope walk was designed and built here in Long Eaton, and can spin up to 20 metre lengths of cord and rope to various dimensions.

Each cord is walked out and twisted individually to create a unique product. The Rope Walk is capable of making a ships rope, although they have never been asked to make one, but many decorative ropes including one for a lighthouse stairs and more recently rope barriers for the Royal Albert Hall.

Braids are warped, set up and woven by hand on one of their traditional looms which are over 40 years old. This enables flexibility in braid width and fringe depth and thickness.

Beautiful tassels for cushions, and tie-backs for drapes are made using wooden templates or wooden moulds covered by hand.

Clients include interior designers, upholstery and the soft furnishing manufacturers, who send it cuttings of fabrics for matching, where colours are twisted together to achieve the desired finish.

The company is often commissioned to make copies of trimmings for antique pieces. One recent project involved researching and making pom pom braid for the Frederick Parker Collection of historic chairs for the Worshipful Company of Furniture Makers in the city of London.
